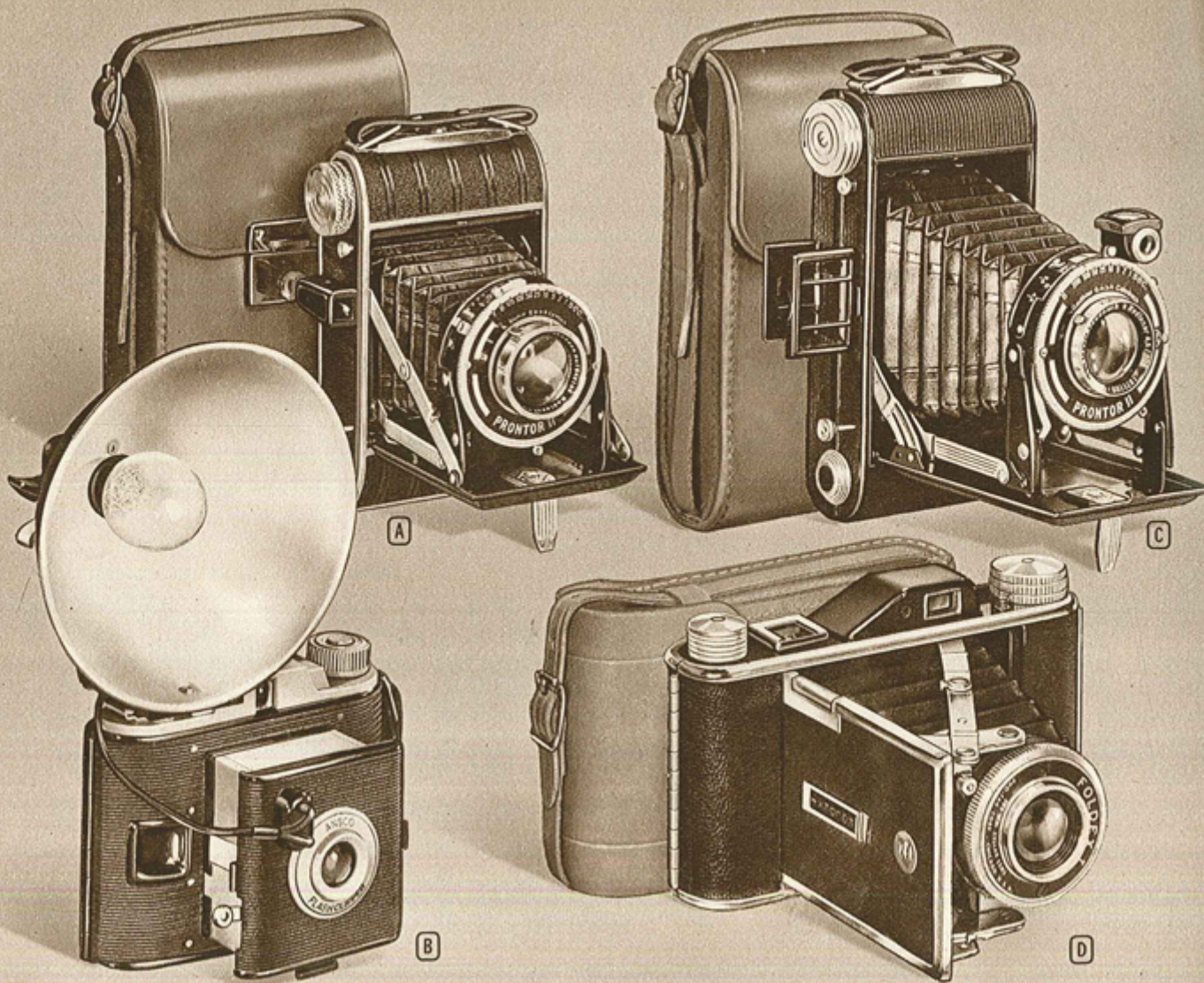

It's Easy to Take Good Pictures With

A SOLIDA FOLDING CAMERA. Small, moderately-priced German made camera with many features found only in more expensive models. Takes both black and white and color pictures. Extra fast $f/2.9$ lens, delayed-action shutter, body shutter release and a shutter speeds from 1 to $1/175$ second. Easy to carry—when closed, camera fits pocket. Ten-second delay action shutter that allows you to get into the picture too. Body shutter release folds flush when camera front is closed. Film-window shutter. Cable release and tripod sockets. Body is of all metal construction.

LENS— $F/2.9$ anastigmat—stops down to $1/22$. 75 mm. focal length. Focuses from $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet to infinity. SHUTTER—Prontor II, eight speeds from 1 to $1/175$ second plus time and bulb. Delayed action. Uses flash gun No. 67 R 3152 on Page 32. VIEWER—Enclosed optical eye-level type. FILM—Eight $2\frac{1}{4}$ by $3\frac{1}{4}$ -inch or sixteen $1\frac{1}{8}$ by $2\frac{1}{4}$ -inch exposures to a roll of 120 (B2) film. CONSTRUCTION—Strong metal body covered with artificial leather. SIZE—About 5 by $3\frac{1}{2}$ by $1\frac{1}{2}$ in. when folded. LENS MOUNT DIAMETER— $1\frac{1}{16}$ inches (33mm.).

B ANSCO FLASH CLIPPER. This handy camera with its detachable synchronized flash unit is as easy to operate as a box camera—takes pictures indoors and out, without waiting for the right natural light.

Detachable flash unit has a 5-inch reflector. The unit plugs in as easily as a radio tube. Bulb ejector. Uses two penlight batteries (order 67 R 3230 from Page 32) and any bayonet base flash bulb on Page 37.

LENS—Fixed focus $f/11$ doublet lens—takes sharp pictures from 8 feet to infinity. SHUTTER—Time and snapshot ($1/25$ second) settings. Synchronized for use with Clipper Flash Unit. VIEWER—tubular optical type. FILM—takes sixteen $2\frac{1}{2}$ by $2\frac{1}{8}$ -inch pictures to roll of 616 (PD16) film. CONSTRUCTION—Sturdy black metal body with water-resistant plastic cover. Metal lens panel retracts for convenient carrying. LENS MOUNT—takes Cloud-on filter and Porton portrait attachment (order 67 R 2219 T on Page 42). SIZE—About 5 by $3\frac{3}{4}$ by $2\frac{1}{4}$ inches folded. Postpaid.

C ROLFIX WITH $F/4.5$ LENS. Imported from Germany . . . handy, moderately-priced folding camera with a fast lens and a Prontor eight-speed, flash synchronized shutter. Delayed action mechanism so you can line up picture, set shutter, and get into the picture yourself before the shutter clicks. Pressure spring back. Two tripod sockets for horizontal or vertical shots. Easy-to-use body shutter release folds flush when camera is closed—raises to upright position when camera is opened.

LENS— $F/4.5$ (105mm) anastigmat lens—stops down to $f/32$, adjustable from 5 feet to infinity. SHUTTER—Prontor II, eight speeds from 1 to $1/200$ second, plus bulb. Synchronized for use with flash gun No. 67 R 3163 on Page 32. Body shutter release. Delayed action. VIEWERS—One waist level finder and eye level type. FILM—Eight or sixteen exposure, $2\frac{1}{4}$ by $3\frac{1}{4}$ in. or $1\frac{1}{8}$ by $2\frac{1}{4}$ in. respectively, on 120 film. CONSTRUCTION—All metal body with black artificial leather cover, measures 6 by 3 by $1\frac{1}{2}$ in. Actual wt. about 1 lb. 9 oz. LENS MOUNT DIAMETER— $1\frac{1}{4}$ in. (32 mm.).

D FOLDEX CAMERA. A new, low-priced folding camera with a flash synchronized shutter. Just the camera for you fans who want folding camera compactness with box camera simplicity. Easy to operate—no shutter speeds or lens aperture to think about. Just find your picture and snap it.

And you don't have to worry about light. You can equip your Foldex Camera with a Foldex Flash Unit and take pictures anywhere, anytime. LENS— $F/11$ fixed focus meniscus, behind-the-shutter type with optical glass in front of shutter for protection. SHUTTER—Time and snapshot ($1/50$ second) settings; synchronized for flash with Foldex Flash Unit. VIEWERS—enclosed optical type. FILM—eight $2\frac{1}{4}$ by $3\frac{1}{4}$ -in. exposures to roll of 120 (B2) or 620 (PB20) film. CONSTRUCTION—Sturdy all metal body, artificial leather covering. LENS MOUNT—Takes both Cloud-on filter and Porton portrait lens attachment (67 R 2219 on Page 42). SIZE about $6 \times 3\frac{3}{4} \times 1\frac{1}{8}$ in. folded.
